Demolition Update

- Demolition Work continued this month on the remaining Bus Ramps.
 Highlights include:
 - Over 46,000 craft hours completed without accident or injury.
 - Completed and turned over to Webcor / Obayashi the center section of the Old Terminal Building Site (Zone 3) for mobilization by BSE Contractor.
 - Continued work on bus ramp demolition from Clementina Street to Harrison Street.
 - Removed Folsom Street overpass during weekend closure, April 15th 17th.
 - Continued concrete debris recycling work at the west end of Old Terminal Building Site.
 - Continued collection and storage of parts for the Timothy Hawkinson art piece.
 - Completed Harrison Street overpass demolition on May 4th.

Utility Relocation Packages


- TG04.1 Natoma Street sewer installation between Fremont and First Streets is completed and tie-ins to the main sewer system in progress. Water line installation is complete. SFWD tie-in and chlorination in progress. Anticipated completion end of July 2011.
- TG04.3 Water pipe installation on Howard Street between First and Main Streets is completed. SFWD tie-in and chlorination in progress. Water pipe installation on Beale Street is completed, SFWD will perform tie-ins after the Howard Street tie-ins are completed. Anticipated completion end of August 2011.
- TG04.4 Water and sewer lines are in progress on Natoma Street between First Street and Second Street, waiting on SFWD for tie-ins. At Natoma and Second Streets work is in progress, being coordinated with PG&E. Anticipated completion end of August 2011.
- TG04.5.1 Minna Street gas tie-ins to building have been completed. Sewer work is approximately 90% complete on First and Minna Streets. Joint trench line on Minna Street is approximately 90% complete. Anticipated completion end of July 2011.
- TG04.6 Potholing is in progress on Mission and Beale Streets. Beale Street sewer work begins at Howard on May 9th. Anticipated completion end of August.

Construction Update


- 301 Mission Street Temporary Wall
 - Completed structural steel erection.
 - Started metal stud framing.
 - Anticipated completion date is early July.
- Transit Center
 - Buttress, Shoring and Excavation (BSE)
 - BSE Preconstruction
 - Weekly submittal coordination meetings with W/O, BBII, PMPC, Turner and Designers continue.
 - BSE Construction
 - BBII has completed about 70% of the controlled wood pile extraction work, anticipated completion is mid-May.
 - BBII moved on to the central section of the original terminal building and will use this area to stage the construction of shoring steel for use in the upcoming shoring wall work. Fabrication of soldier piles started May 2nd.
 - Pre-trenching for the CDSM shoring wall began April 11th in Zone 4. A May 30th start of the CDSM shoring in zone 4 (the east end) is anticipated.
 - Pre-trenching in Zone 3 is anticipated to begin by mid-May.
 - Instrumentation installation is underway by ARUP, scheduled to be complete by end of May.












Water and Sewer at Fremont, First and Natoma Streets








Controlled Wood Pile Extraction Continues in Zone 4










