COVID - Masks Required in Transit Settings Per TSA through March 18

Transportation Security Administration's mandate, which requires travelers to mask up on airplanes, trains, buses and in airports and transit stations.

Signs & Displays supporting the continued facial covering requirements on all levels and adjacent elevators.

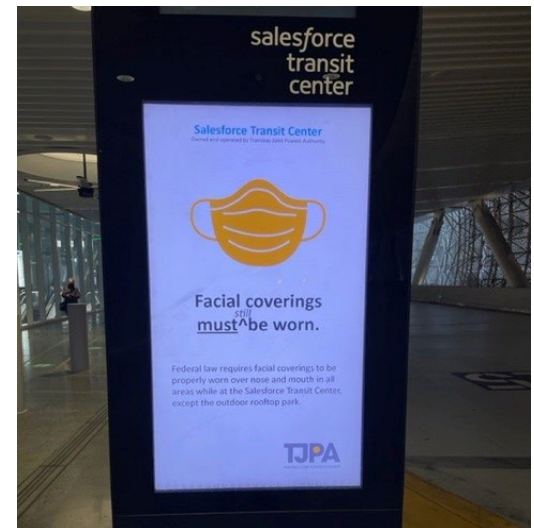
Recordings play 2 times per hour (7:00 am – Midnight) – stating “Facial Coverings are Mandatory.”

- Recording does not play in the Park as masking is not required there.

High touch surfaces continue to receive frequent cleaning as has been true since March 2020 (railings, buttons, tabletops).

HVAC in offices – air movement on HIGH and using MERV-16 filters (providing greater filtration than CAL-OSHA MERV-13 standard).

Center designed to use fresh air movement throughout Grand Hall & Bus Deck.



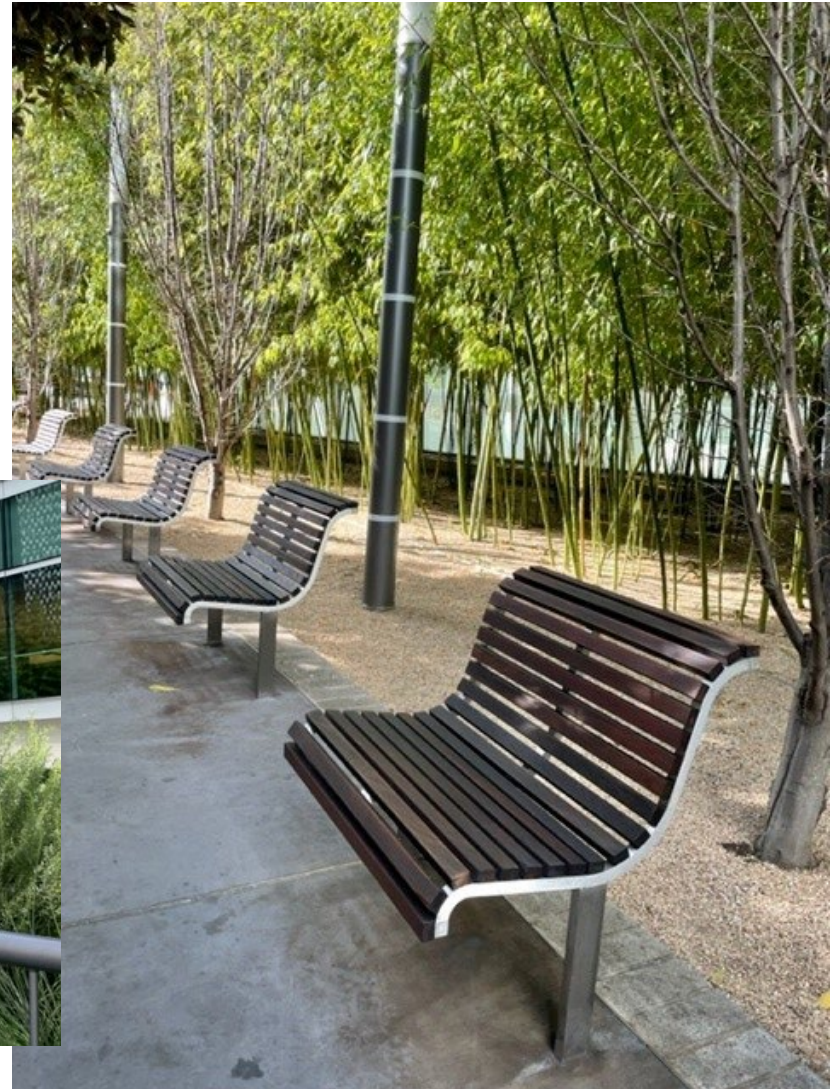
Wayfinding Upgrades

- Working through permitting to place 3 transit kiosks on surrounding sidewalks to help riders find Transit Center
- Updating Grand Hall decal to be more visible and with new guidance to Beale Street.
- Transit Information Display frames shipped this week. Install expected to be completed no later than end of February.
