Special Notices:

Transit Center Status

Areas of the Transit Center that are operational and open to the public:

- Muni Plaza (serving Muni located on the Street Level between Beale and Fremont streets).
- The Grand Hall (located at Street Level between Fremont and First streets).
- The Greyhound Passenger Ticketing and Waiting Area (located on the 2nd Level at the west end of the Transit Center near Second Street).
- The Bus Deck (serving buses from AC Transit, Greyhound, WestCAT Lynx, and the Muni Treasure Island bus located on the 3rd Level spanning the entire length of the Transit Center between Beale Street and Second Street).
- The Roof Park (with food, drinks and year round free activities Salesforcetransitcenter.com/events located on the 4th Level spanning the entire length of the Transit Center between Beale and Second streets).

Construction continues in areas not open to the public at the Western end of the street level of the Transit Center. The areas that are not yet open to the public due to ongoing construction are clearly demarcated and are scheduled to be complete in the next few months. All remaining construction within any areas open to the public (e.g. ceiling panels on the Bus Deck and at the Muni Plaza) will occur at night to minimize impacts to the public.

Minna Street final paving is scheduled to take place on Saturday, September 8th. Minna Street will be closed (between First Street and Second Street) from 5:00AM to 7:00PM that day.


Tenant Improvement Work
