## Transit Investment in Greenhouse Gas and Energy Reduction

- \$100 million available nationwide; applications total more than \$1.87 billion
- TJPA applied for \$8.4 million for Geothermal System and \$16.6 million for Lighting Efficiencies and Daylighting
- Grant awards announced by FTA by September 30, 2009

## TIGER

**Transbay Transit Center** 

#### Grants for Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery

- \$1.5 billion available nationwide at the discretion of the USDOT Secretary
- Multi-modal major capital investments
- TJPA requested \$62 million for Utility Relocation; submitted application directly to USDOT on September 4
- Grant awards announced by February 17, 2010



High Speed and Intercity Passenger Rail (HSIPR)

- \$8 billion available nationwide
- High Speed and Intercity Passenger Rail projects
- FRA selects projects
- Track 1 project selections to be announced by October 2009



High Speed and Intercity Passenger Rail (HSIPR)

- California's application includes \$400 million for Train Box
- Total Track 1 requested by California is \$1.149 billion
- Train Box is ranked #13 out of 38 California Track 1 projects
