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WORK-BASED LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

- ❑ Business Speakers-speaking engagements tied to curriculum
- ❑ Field Trips-meaningful field trips with prep and reflection, tied to curriculum
- ❑ Job Shadows-1-5 students shadowing business partner for 1-6 hours, tied to curriculum with prep and reflection
- ❑ Informational Interviews-Students lead conversations about the business person's industry, company and personal career path
- ❑ Extended Job Shadows-students report to the same business 2 hours a week for 6 weeks
- ❑ Internships- 20/hours per week for 6 weeks, 3/hours per week in class
