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SBE/DBE Program Goals/Objectives

- 1. Create a level playing field on which SBE/DBE firms can complete fairly for TJPA contracts.
- 2. Remove barriers to SBE/DBE participation in the bidding, award and administration of TJPA contracts.
- 3. Assist SBE/DBE firms to develop and compete successfully outside of the Program.
- 4. Ensure that only SBE/DBE firms meeting the eligibility requirements are allowed to participate in the Program.
- 5. Identify business enterprises that are qualified as SBE/DBE firms and are qualified to provide the TJPA with required materials, services, supplies and services; and to develop a good rapport with the owners, managers and sales representatives of those enterprises.

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Commercially Useful Function (CUF)

A business performing a CUF is one that does all of the following:

- Is responsible for the execution of a distinct element of the work of the contract.
- Carries out its obligation by actually performing managing or supervising the work involved .
- Performs work that is normal for its business, services and function.
- Is not further subcontracting a portion of the work that is greater than that expected to be subcontracted by normal industry practices.



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CUF Evaluation Test

- Is the supplier (whether it is the prime or a subcontractor) responsible for the execution of a distinct element of the resulting contract?
- Will the supplier actually be performing, managing, or supervising an element of the resulting contract?
- Will the supplier be performing work that is normal for its business, services and function?
- Is there are further subcontracting that is greater than that expected to be subcontracted by normal industry practices?



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Calculating Participation Values

• SBE TRADE SUBCONTRATOR

- Work performed or services provided by the SBE's own work forces, including the cost of the materials and supplies-100%.
- Work performed or services provided by the SBE's own forces, including the cost of materials and supplies obtained for work, except for materials and supplies purchased or leased from Prime. If work has been subcontracted to another SBE, it will be counted as SBE participation by that other SBE.

• SBE JV PARTNER

 Count that portion of the work that is performed solely by the SBE's forces or equal to the SBE's percentage of ownership interest in the JV if the work is not clearly delineated between SBE and JV partner.





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Calculating Participation Values

SBE MATERIALS SUPPLIER

Count 60% of the costs of materials and supplies obtained from a SBE Materials
Supplier (Meeting CUF requirements).

PASS THRU/BROKER

Count the entire amount of <u>fees or commissions charged for assistance in</u>
 <u>procuring or delivering materials</u> and supplies when purchased from a SBE that
 is not a manufacturer or regular dealer. Do not count the cost of the materials
 and supplies.

SBE TRUCKING COMPANY

 Count the entire amount (100%) of the transportation services provided using trucks it owns, insures, and operates with its own employees.
