## **STAFF REPORT FOR CALENDAR ITEM NO.:** 9 **FOR THE MEETING OF:** September 13, 2012

### TRANSBAY JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY

#### **BRIEF DESCRIPTION**

On February 15, 2007, the TJPA Board of Directors approved the appointment of the fifteen inaugural members to the TJPA Citizens Advisory Committee (TJPA CAC). The inaugural CAC meeting was held in April of 2007, and the newly appointed members drew lots to determine which would serve initial one year terms and which would serve full two year terms. The expiration of subsequent terms has been staggered accordingly.

The TJPA CAC bylaws specify that members be selected to represent the following constituent categories:

- 1. Daily Caltrain Rider into San Francisco
- 2. Daily AC Transit Transbay Rider into San Francisco
- 3. Daily MUNI Rider on a line that terminates at or passes through the Transbay Terminal
- 4. Local Resident from District 6
- 5. Local Business from District 6
- 6. Environmentalist
- 7. Member of a planning or good-government non-profit organization
- 8. Representative from labor
- 9. Bicycle advocate
- 10. Disabled advocate
- 11. San Francisco based public transit advocate
- 12. Regional transit advocate
- 13. Regional transit advocate
- 14. Member of the citywide (San Francisco) business community
- 15. Member with expertise in real estate development or real estate finance

The criteria for membership were established to ensure a qualified committee of regional stakeholders with a diverse array of knowledge and interest/advocacy aligned with the principal components that define the Program. Membership requires affiliation with at least one category, and the bylaws further specify that this mix of representation be preserved when replacement members are appointed to the CAC.

The TJPA solicited applications for new and returning members between January 2012 and March 2012 with applications for membership accepted through March 23, 2012. The TJPA received twenty-one applications including six current members who reapplied.

At the May 10, 2012 meeting, staff brought to the Board of Directors recommendations for eight appointments to the CAC. The Board approved seven of those appointments, but requested that staff conduct additional outreach for a candidate to fill the Environmentalist seat.

Based on the additional outreach, the TJPA received four additional applications. After reviewing all applications, staff is recommending that the Board of Directors appoint Mark Garcia as a new member to fill the Environmentalist seat.

### APPLICATION SOLICITATION OUTREACH

Prior to forming the CAC, TJPA staff developed, and the TJPA Board of Directors approved, an application for membership that asks for qualifications for membership, a statement of the applicant's objectives and goals, and affiliation(s) and references. This same application has been used in soliciting new members.

The call for applications was posted on the TJPA website at <a href="www.transbaycenter.org/cac">www.transbaycenter.org/cac</a>, distributed via e-newsletter to the more than 250 people on the TJPA outreach list, shared with TJPA board members, and distributed to various community organizations including:

Finally, applications were available at the TJPA Office. The TJPA received applications at the office in person and via US Postal Service, facsimile, and e-mail.

### APPLICATIONS RECEIVED

The deadline for applications was March 23, 2012. As of that date, the TJPA had received two applications for the Environmentalist seat. In an effort to solicit a broader pool of new applicants after the May Board meeting, the announcement was redistributed to the TJPA outreach list, TJPA Board members and the community based organizations listed above. This extension resulted in the receipt of four additional applications.

The four new applications for membership are from men of which two applicants are San Francisco residents and two are from the East Bay. The applicants included one Korean American, one Hispanic, one African American, and one Caucasian.

After applications closed, one of the candidates withdrew his application, and, in so doing, endorsed the application of Mark Garcia.

### RECOMMENDATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE TJPA CAC

The Staff recommends approval of Mark Garcia for appointment in the environmental category, pursuant to Article 2, Section 4 of the Bylaws of the Transbay Joint Powers Authority Citizens Advisory Committee. The recommended candidate is a male Hispanic from Contra Costa County.

### **NEXT STEPS**

The attached resolution appoints one recommended applicant for membership on the TJPA CAC. The appointed member will be invited to the next meeting of the TJPA CAC, which will be held on October 9, 2012 at the TJPA offices at 201 Mission Street, Suite 2100.
