



Public Meeting on June 20, 2013, at 6 p.m. Proposed AC Transit Bus Staging

AC Transit is operating from the Transbay Temporary Terminal during construction of the future Transbay Transit Center. AC Transit uses a lot near the terminal and on-street parking areas to stage its buses in preparation for the evening commute Monday through Friday from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m.

A new construction project scheduled to begin this fall will require AC Transit to vacate the parking lot it is currently using and find another alternative.

In an effort find an alternative staging location, AC Transit has consulted with the Transbay Joint Powers Authority and the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) to evaluate potential staging options and has identified the following sections of streets as the most viable. These are shown on the map on the reverse.

- **MAIN STREET, west side parking lane** between Mission and Howard streets would be designated "tow away except bus staging M-F, 3-7 p.m."
- **PREMONT STREET, one of the two east side northbound travel lanes** between Harrison and Folsom streets would be closed Monday through Friday, 3-7 p.m. This adds bus staging capacity to the current use of the east side parking lane.
- **3 FOLSOM STREET, north side parking lane** between Third and Fourth streets* would be designated "tow away except bus staging M-F, 3-7 p.m."
 - * Bus staging on Fremont Street will move to Folsom Street when directed by the City for work under the Rincon Hill Area Plan.

These restrictions would ONLY apply between the hours of 3 p.m. and 7 p.m., Monday through Friday.

A public meeting will be held to present this proposal and request public comment on Thursday, June 20, 2013, at 6 p.m., at 201 Mission Street, Suite 2100. SFMTA will post notices for a Traffic Hearing on this proposal at a future date.
