



Transbay Transit Center

Thank you for your ongoing support of the Transbay Transit Center project

We are pleased to report that one year after the August 2010 groundbreaking the project has made excellent progress and remains on budget and on schedule.

The demolition phase of the project is now complete, clearing the way for construction of the Transbay Transit Center. Phase 1 (the Center with the rail levels) will be completed by 2017. Demolition entailed nearly 55,000 hours of labor, *all of which were completed without accident or injury.*

During demolition:

- Over 92,000 cubic yards of concrete were recycled, enough to fill 28 Olympic size swimming pools.
- Over 7500 tons of steel were recycled.
- Since January of 2011 over 1000 workers have been employed.

Approximately 88% of the demolition work was completed using local labor

We have now started the construction of the foundation work for the below-grade level of the new Center. We expect to continue hiring more workers and generating more revenue for our economy as the construction progresses. As a reminder, approximately 48,000 jobs will be generated by Phase 1 and 78,000 by Phase 2 (the downtown rail extension).
