Complete the Petition Phase At least 30% of the Proposed Private Property Weighted Assessments Must be Affirmative **Board of Supervisors Hearing Resolution of Intent to Begin Balloting Ballots Mailed and Voting by Property Owners – mid-June Coordinate with and Support the Department of Elections** Ballots Tabulated - end of July More than 50% of the Weighted Vote in Favor Required **Board of Supervisors Vote to Form CBD**
