# CONTRACT SECURITY KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

<b>Personnel Turnover</b>					
Definition	Must be able to place and retain personnel who will deliver consistent, and high-quality service.				
Calculation	Employees terminated/resigned during this period divided by the number of employees who began this period.				
Thresholds	<b>Meets fully</b> 0% 4	<b>Meets consistently</b> 19%-15% 3	<b>Generally Meets</b> 24%-20% 2	<b>Often doesn't meet</b> 29%-25% 1	<b>Does Not Meet</b> 30%-> 0
Results	There was no turnover during this period				
<b>Post Staffing</b>					
Definition	All critical posts are to be staffed by trained and licensed personnel on a consistent basis.				
Calculation	The number of actual hours divided by the number of expected hours during the period.				
Thresholds	<b>Meets fully</b> 100-95% 4	<b>Meets consistently</b> 94.99% - 90% 3	<b>Generally Meets</b> 89.99%-85.00% 2	<b>Often doesn't meet</b> 84.99%-80.00% 1	<b>Does Not Meet</b> 79.00%-> 0
Results	AUS staffing resulted in a score of 97%.				
<b>Post &amp; Site Competency Testing</b>					
Definition	Testing will be administered monthly to Eight (8) random posts to ensure compliance.				
Calculation	Personnel must pass with at least 85%—the total sum of test scores divided by 24.				
Thresholds	<b>Meets fully</b> 100-95% 4	<b>Meets consistently</b> 94.99% - 90% 3	<b>Generally Meets</b> 89.99%-85.00% 2	<b>Often doesn't meet</b> 84.99%-80.00% 1	<b>Does Not Meet</b> 79.00%-> 0
Results	Twenty-four tests were administered this period resulting in an overall score of 87%.






