

- Public Transportation Modernization, Improvement and Service Enhancement Account
- State-Local Partnership Program
- Transit System Safety, Security and Disaster Response
- Intercity Rail



State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)

- \$190 million in new highway capacity to the region
- \$107 million in additional new Public Transportation Account revenues
- Programmed for FY 2006-07 through 2010-11
- San Francisco County total target is \$49 million new funds plus \$18 million replacement funds, for a total of \$67 million

Feb. 1, 2007	Draft project nominations due to MTC from CMAs (SFCTA)
Feb. 13, 2007	SFCTA Plans & Programs Committee adopts project priorities and recommends to SFCTA Commission
Feb. 27, 2007	SFCTA adopts project priorities for 2006 STIP
Feb. 28, 2007	Final complete project applications due to MTC
March 28, 2007	MTC approves 2006 STIP Augmentation
May 2, 2007	CTC hearing on 2006 STIP (No. Calif.)
June 7, 2007	CTC adopts 2006 STIP
