TRANSBAY JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

Approval of the First Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the TJPA and the San Francisco Bay Area Water Transit Authority (WTA) to change the expiration date of the MOU from February 28, 2007 to June 30, 2007.

SUMMARY:

The MOU dated October 27, 2006 between the TJPA and the WTA authorizes the TJPA to pay \$60,000 to the WTA upon completion of a Ridership Study and Report to be prepared by Cambridge Systematics for the WTA. The Study and Report will forecast train ridership at the new Transit Center to support the calculation of passenger facilities charges (PFCs) that would be used to repay a TIFIA loan to the TJPA. The MOU was scheduled to expire on February 28, 2007. Due to circumstances beyond the control of the TJPA or the WTA, the Ridership Study and Report was not completed by February 28, 2007. Accordingly, the TJPA Staff requests that the Board extend the MOU to June 30, 2007. This Amendment will allow the TJPA to pay \$60,000 upon completion and acceptance of the Ridership Study and Report.
