STAFF REPORT FOR CALENDAR ITEM NO.: 9 **FOR THE MEETING OF:** June 12, 2025

TRANSBAY JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

On February 15, 2007, the TJPA Board of Directors approved the appointment of the fifteen inaugural members to the TJPA Citizens Advisory Committee (TJPA CAC). The inaugural CAC meeting was held in April 2007, and the newly appointed members drew lots to determine which would serve initial one-year terms and which would serve full two-year terms. The expiration of subsequent terms has been staggered accordingly.

The TJPA CAC bylaws specify that members be selected to represent the following constituent categories:

- 1. Daily Caltrain Rider into San Francisco
- 2. Daily AC Transit Transbay Rider into San Francisco
- 3. Daily MUNI Rider on a line that terminates at or passes through the Transbay Terminal
- 4. Local Resident from District 6 (zip code 94105 or 94107)
- 5. Local Business from District 6 (zip code 94105 or 94107)
- 6. Environmentalist
- 7. Member of a Planning or Good-Government Non-Profit Organization
- 8. Representative from Labor
- 9. Bicycle Advocate
- 10. Disabled Advocate
- 11. San Francisco Based Public Transit Advocate
- 12. Regional Transit Advocate
- 13. Regional Transit Advocate
- 14. Member of the Citywide (San Francisco) Business Community
- 15. Member with Expertise in Real Estate Development or Real Estate Finance

The criteria for membership were established to ensure a qualified committee of regional stakeholders with a diverse array of knowledge and interest/advocacy aligned with the principal components that define the Transbay Program. Membership requires affiliation with at least one category, and the bylaws further specify that this mix of representations be preserved when replacement members are appointed to the CAC.

In May 2025, Charley Lavery vacated the Member of the Citywide (San Francisco) Business Community seat, therefore, we are recommending a mid-term appointment.

APPLICATION SOLICITATION OUTREACH

Prior to forming the CAC, TJPA staff developed, and the TJPA Board of Directors approved, an application for membership that asks for qualifications for membership, a statement of the applicant's objectives and goals, and affiliation(s) and references. This same application has been used in soliciting new members.

In reviewing the applications received from the 2024 and 2025 recruitment efforts, staff found four applicants met the criteria as a Member of the Citywide (San Francisco) Business Community category. TJPA reviewed four applications from two men and two undeclared, who are all San Francisco residents. The applicants' ethnicity included one Asian, one Caucasian, and two undeclared individuals. After reviewing those applications, staff is recommending that the Board of Directors appoint Henry Karnilowicz as a new member to fill the Member of the Citywide (San Francisco) Business Community seat.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE TJPA CAC

Staff recommends approval of Henry Karnilowicz for appointment in the indicated category, pursuant to Article 2, Section 4 of the Bylaws of the Transbay Joint Powers Authority Citizens Advisory Committee. The recommended member is a Caucasian male and a San Francisco Resident.

NEXT STEPS

The attached resolution appoints the recommended applicant for membership to the TJPA CAC. Upon approval, the appointed member will be invited to the next meeting of the TJPA CAC on July 8, 2025. Meetings are held at the TJPA office at 425 Mission Street, Suite 250, San Francisco, CA 94105.
