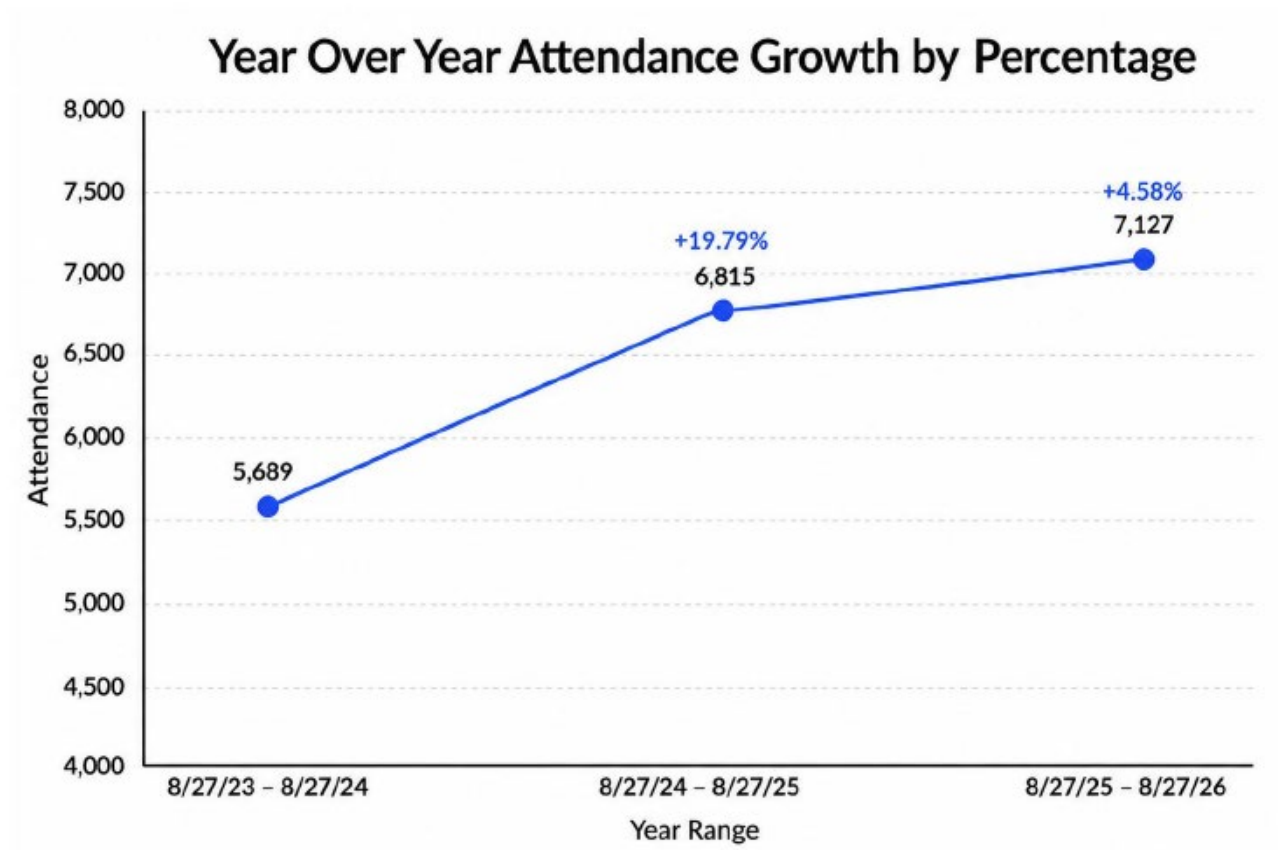

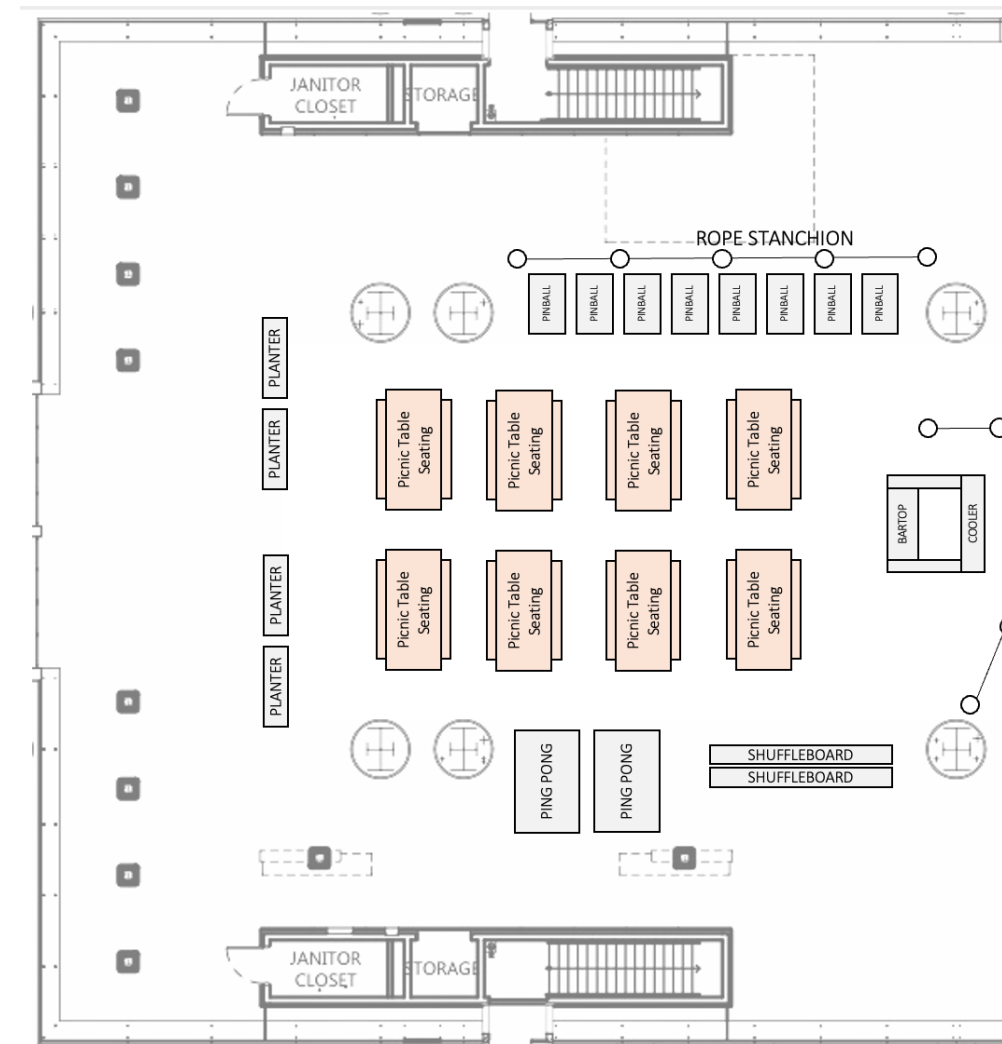

TOURISM — RECORD YEAR

SF's visitor economy is on track to top its 2019 record in 2026 — **24.2M visitors** and **\$9.9B in spending**, with Moscone running **38 events / 674K+ room nights**. This week's **Pokémon World Championships** (50,000+ fans, Aug 28–30) is a short walk from the Center via the future Minna–Natoma corridor.
